GENERAL NOTES FOR ALL FOUR TYPES OF TREE WELL

- TREE WELLS SHOULD BE SPACED APPROXIMATELY 50' (15 m) APART, BUT NOT LESS THAN ONE PER RESIDENTIAL LOT.
- LOCATION OF TREE WELLS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM CLEARANCES: A. 50' (15 m) FROM BCR ON THE APPROACH TO AN INTERSECTION 2.

AND 15' (4.5 m) FROM THE ECR ON THE EXIT SIDE.

- B. 20' (6 m) FROM LIGHT STANDARDS.
 C. 10' (3 m) FROM FIRE HYDRANTS AND DRIVEWAYS.
 D. 5' (1.5 m) FROM HOUSE WALKS AND UTILITY METERS.
- 3. COVERS SHALL BE COLORED BUFF USING AN ACCEPTABLE COLORING AGENT.
- TREE WELL SHALL BE BACKFILLED WITH CLEAN DIRT FLUSH WITH ADJACENT WALK UNTIL TREE IS PLANTED.
- 5. DO NOT USE CASE 1 OR CASE 2 TREE WELL WHERE THERE IS AN EXISTING FENCE OR WALL AT THE R/W LINE.
- TOP OF TREE WELL COVER SHALL BE FLUSH WITH ADJACENT SIDEWALK. 6.
- 7. LOCATION OF TREE SUBJECT TO CHANGE AT THE DIRECTION OF THE ENGINEER.
